

Facts and details about the 500 new, local jobs created by table games, according to Al Britton, General Manager of CTRS, in a meeting with Lynn Welsh and Keryn Newman on November 4, 2009:

500 Jobs

100 – Supervisory positions that require *prior experience* with table games. We do not have locals with the required experience, so these jobs will be filled by people from other areas.

50 – Maintenance, waitress and security jobs that will pay entry level wages, far less than the promised \$45,000 per year salary rate.

350 – Dealer jobs that will pay *\$7.00 – 10.00 per hour plus tips*. Tips are pooled and distributed by management in dealer paychecks and make up the lion's share of the expected \$45,000 per year salary.

For inexperienced candidates, dealer jobs require training to be administered at the track by Blue Ridge Community & Technical College lasting anywhere from between 8 to 16 weeks. Students must pay for their courses in advance, with reimbursement by CTRS contingent upon satisfactory completion and being hired as a dealer.

Number of table games to be added: 85 – 100.
