**“Creating new jobs”** These entry level jobs have traditionally been filled by foreign workers and dealers imported from other areas. Mountaineer Park has had three sets of layoffs (over 300 positions) since table games were installed in 2007.

**“More funding for education”** Their projections don't kick in until 2012; by then Maryland will have slots and the projections will shrink considerably. These restricted funds will not go to teachers' salaries. There could be no net gain if Charleston decides Jefferson County has sufficient funds through current sources.

**“Maintaining quality of life”** Our horse and farming industries will be put at risk; only a fraction of funding is allocated to purse money compared to slots. Since table games were installed at Mountaineer Park in 2007, purses have been cut by almost a third.
